

Digital Donut Example • Quick Start Field Guide



Shutterbug Sam Says:

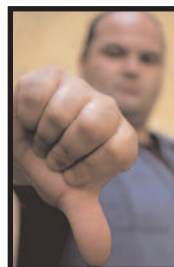
Please LOOK CAREFULLY at the donut illustration. Avoid example #1 and #2 below. These Digital Donut images are too big and too small.

#3 is just perfect. Your donut image has to just KISS the inside of the top and bottom. You should see BLACK on the left and right side of your donut image. If you do not follow this, then your images will look distorted or will have that fisheye look. Not good.

Sam says: Practice, Practice, Practice!

WAY TOO BIG!

If you exceed the top and bottom and your donut kisses the left + right side of the frame, your final tour will look fish-eye. Not good.

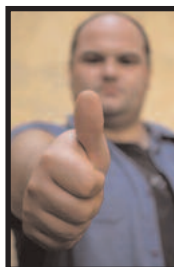


NOPE. TOO SMALL.

Close but no cigar. This donut image HAS to kiss the top and bottom of the frame. This tour will look too small or distorted when you unwrap it. Yuk!

PICTURE PERFECT!

This is ideal REGARDLESS of which digital camera you own. The top and bottom kiss the frame. This will be a perfect tour when you unwrap it.
